1. Conference outline

Date: October 28th to 30th, 2016

- October 28th (Fri): Technical Tour, student competition examination board, and presidents' meeting
- October 29th (Sat): Symposium (keynote speech, presentations from each country, and panel discussion) and party
- October 30th (Sun): Research presentation, poster session, and farewell party

Venue: Yayoi Auditorium, University of Tokyo, Japan (address: 1-1-1, Yayoi, Bunkyo, Tokyo, Japan)

Main theme: Landscape as Urban Infrastructure

2. Thematic focus of paper

The conference seeks submissions presenting novel research results in all practical and theoretical aspects of landscape architecture based on the four subjects below. All the submitted papers will be printed in the conference proceedings and published in electronic format as an eBook.

1) Ecological Infrastructure

- Conservation, restoration, management of natural environment including wetland, grassland, forest and agricultural land, from ecological point of view
- Theoretical, institutional, and practical approaches for land use planning for maintaining ecosystem services
- And other relevant topics

2) Social Infrastructure

- Maintenance of civil infrastructure such as road, river, reservoir, river and coastal

levees, park and greenway etc.

- Sustainable landscaping on artificial environment such as greening in urban areas, creating bioswale, bioretention, or raingarden for urban flood mitigation, urban renewal and vegetation management on brownfield
- And other relevant topics

3) Historical & Cultural Infrastructure

- Maintaining cultural landscape as visual representation of human-nature living relations
- Restoration, preservation, and succession of traditional knowledge accumulated by lives of local people for maintaining landscapes
- And other relevant topics

4) Field Experience of Landscape Planning and Design

- Introducing leading practices of landscape planning and design; Green infrastructure, park and greenway, ecosystem restoration, heat island mitigation, urban design for improving built environment, technology development for urban greenery, urban green management etc.
- Contributions from practitioners would be highly welcomed

3. Submission deadline and guidelines for manuscript

- Submission due date: **July 19, 2016**
- Language: English (grammatically correct, nontechnical, simple, clear and concise manner)
- Pages limits: Less than 4,800 words, including abstract (200-300words), references, table and figure
- File format: Microsoft word, in A4 size paper
- Font type: Times New Roman
- Font size: 1) Title: 12pt, 2) Author and affiliation: 11pt, 3) Abstract: 10pt, 4) Key words (less than 5 words): 10pt, 5) Main text: 10pt, 6) Reference: 10pt
- Resolution of figures: Over 300dpi
- Example of Manuscript contents: Title, Author and Affiliation, e-mail (only corresponding author), Abstract, Key words (less than 5 words), Main text (Introduction/Method/Result and discussion/Conclusion/Reference)

All the paper contributors would be able to present their outcomes in the poster session scheduled on October 30th. Posters should be made in A0 size (vertical) and be printed by authors.
